
# The Twist

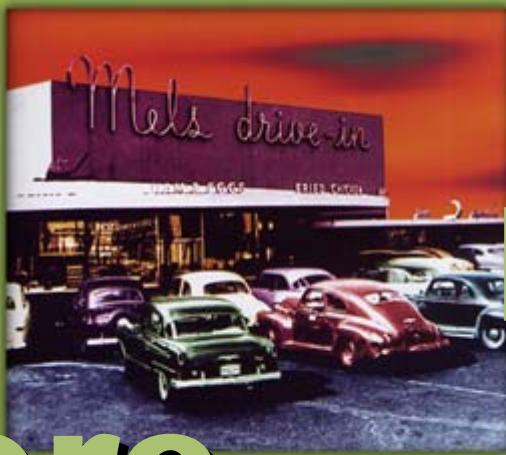

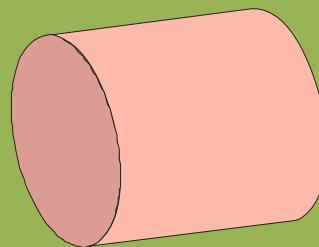
